**CONFIRMATION OF INTENTION NOT TO APPLY TO THE PLANNING INSPECTORATE FOR
A DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER, AT THIS TIME.**

Dear Harri,

I am writing to you on behalf of Ossian Offshore Wind Farm Limited (the "Applicant") to confirm that, following changes to Ossian's grid design, we are pausing work on the transmission infrastructure which connects the windfarm to the National Grid at substations in Lincolnshire.

At this time, Ossian is withdrawing from the Development Consent Order (DCO) pre-application process for the connections to Lincolnshire. However, Ossian's connections to Lincolnshire are integral to the Project's overall proposals, and we intend to recommence our application for a DCO at a future date. We remain committed to providing updates to the Planning Inspectorate and stakeholders as and when we can.

The Ossian team is grateful to the Planning Inspectorate and the numerous stakeholders who have engaged with us to date. The feedback received will help us shape the proposals as we take them forward in the future.
